How to get to the venue

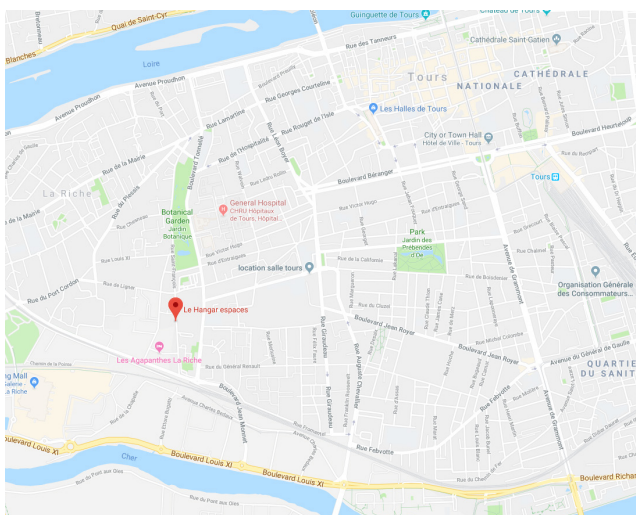
The venue is located close to University Hospital Bretonneau
